

Report on the 2021 Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary Campus Climate Survey

Fall 2021

The Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary Campus Climate Survey is designed by RIETS Campus Climate Survey Committee to ascertain general awareness and knowledge of the institution's prevention and response to sexual assault. In Fall 2021, all RIETS students were invited to take the survey. The survey is anonymous and confidential. Of the total of 232 RIETS students, 38 students responded to the survey, resulting in a response rate of 16.4%. Following are the results of the survey.
