## Policy on Credit for Advanced Placement Examination

Students who have taken the Advance Placement Examination in high school may qualify for college credit.

1. A score of 1, 2, or 3 does not earn credit or exemption.
2. A score of 4 or 5 earns credit for the equivalent course. In Computer Science $A$ and Physics, a score of 5 is required to earn credit.

Notes
(1) One additional credit may be granted for laboratory experience. Submit a detailed syllabus to the Department Chair. Biology majors who receive 7 will need to take Biology 1012 lab. Biology majors who receive 6 credits will need to Biology 1011 and 1012 labs. Non-biology majors may still need to take labs if the graduate program they will be applying to requires 8 credits of Biology Principles.
(2) Students may not take a foreign language $A P$ examination in their native language.
(3) Not toward major, minor or Interpreting Literature and the Arts of General Education Requirements.
(4) For Stern College Students Only: students who want to take more advanced Computer Science courses must pass a Python 3 exam (at the 80\% level) administered by the Computer Science department. Upon doing so, the 4 credits for General Elective will be changed to 4 credits for COMP 1300C.
(5) Credits granted for MATH 1412 with AB sub score of 4 or 5 .
(6) Biology and Chemistry majors need to take lab CHEM 1047 L which may also be required for certain graduate programs.
(7) THE JERUSALEM EXAMINATION: Credit is awarded depending upon the score earned. A combined score on Parts I and II of 150 earns 3 credits of a Hebrew elective. A combined score on Parts I and II of 160 or above earns 6 credits of Hebrew electives. Regardless of the credits earned, the number of Hebrew courses to be taken at SCW is determined by the SCW Hebrew Placement Exam.
