# How To: Forget WiFi Network - "YU Wireless" or "YU Housing" for ALL DEVICES

#### **Overview**

If you are experiencing issues when trying to connect to "YU Wireless" or "YU Housing" WiFi, please follow the instructions below for your device

#### The general process is:

- 1. Forget ALL YU wireless networks or your connection will never work. See Below:
  - YUWireless
  - YUHousing
  - YUWifi
- 2. Restart Device
- 3. Re-Connect to "YU Wireless" or "YU Housing"

#### Windows 10 and 11

## Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 


- YUWireless
- YUHousing
- YUWifi
- 1. Select the **Network** icon on the taskbar.
  - The icon that appears depends on your current connection state. If you don't see one of the network icons, select the **Up arrow** to see if it appears there.




2. Click **Network & Internet settings**.



3. Click **Wi-Fi** on the left panel under **Settings**. > Then click on **Manage known networks** 



- 4. Under Manage known networks, click "YU Wireless" or "YU Housing"
- 5. Click **Forget.** The wireless network profile is deleted.



- 6. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 7. **Restart your device** (Highly recommended), or your next connection may NOT work

# Step 2: Reconnect to WiFi (Windows)

- 1. Select the **Network** icon on the taskbar. The icon that appears depends on your current connection state.
  - If you don't see one of the network icons (or a similar one), select the **Up** arrow to see if it appears there.


- 2. Choose YU Wireless or YU Housing, then select Connect.
- 3. Type your YUAD login credentials, and then select **Next**.
  - "YU Wireless" credentials are entered differently than "YU Housing"
  - See section "Authentication" at the bottom of this article on how to enter credentials depending on WiFi name
- 4. Choose **Yes** or **No**, depending on the type of network you're connecting to and if you want your PC to be discoverable by other PCs and devices on the network.

**MacBook or iMac** (iOS Laptop or Desktop from Apple)


## **Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:**

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 

- YUWireless
- YUHousing
- YUWifi
- 1. Choose Apple menu  $\square$  > **System Preferences**, then click **Network**.
- 2. Select Wi-Fi in the list on the left.



- 3. Click the Advanced button.
- 4. The Wi-Fi pane shows a Preferred Networks list. Select **YU Wireless** from the list that you want your Mac to forget.



- 5. Click the remove button (-) beneath the list. If you're asked to confirm, click **Remove**.
- 6. Click OK.
- 7. Click Apply.
- 8. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 9. Restart your device, or your next connection may NOT work

# Step 2: Reconnect to WiFi (Mac OS)

You can use the Wi-Fi menu to quickly connect to a nearby wireless network.



- 1. Click the Wi-Fi icon (  $\bigcirc$  or  $\bigcirc$  ) in the menu bar.
- 2. If Wi-Fi is off, choose "Turn Wi-Fi on."
- 3. Choose YU Wireless or YU Housing, then select Connect.
- 4. Type your YUAD login credentials, and then select **Next**.
  - "YU Wireless" credentials are entered differently than "YU Housing"
  - See section "Authentication" at the bottom of this article on how to enter credentials depending on WiFi name
- 5. If credentials are entered correctly, you will see the WiFi successfully connected.

### **Troubleshooting for Apple Devices:**

WiFi issues are common in apple devices

If you are still unable to connect, FIRST make sure you are entering the correct credentials

Log into InsideTrack or Canvas by entering credentials MANUALLY

If you can log into InsideTrack or Canvas manually, these will be the same credentials to connect to WiFi at YU

# iPhone/iPad (Apple iOS):

# **Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:**

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 

- YUWireless
- YUHousing

- YUWifi
- 1. Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi.**
- 2. Tap (i) next to "YU Wireless".
- 3. Tap "Forget This Network", then tap "Forget" to confirm.
- 4. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 5. **Restart your device**, or your next connection may NOT work

#### **Step 2: Reconnect to WiFi**

- 1. From your **Home screen**, go to **Settings** > **Wi-Fi.**
- 2. Turn on Wi-Fi. Your device will automatically search for available Wi-Fi networks.
- 3. Choose YU Wireless or YU Housing, then select Connect.
- 4. Type your YUAD login credentials, and then select **Next**.
  - "YU Wireless" credentials are entered differently than "YU Housing"
  - See section "Authentication" at the bottom of this article on how to enter credentials depending on WiFi name
- 5. If credentials are entered correctly, you'll see a blue checkmark  $\checkmark$  next to the network and the connected Wi-Fi icon  $\bigcirc$  in the upper corner of your display.

## **Android - Phone / Tablet**

# **Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:**

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 

- YUWireless
- YUHousina
- YUWifi
- 1. Open your device's Settings app.
- 2. Tap **Network & internet** > **Internet**.
- 3. Touch and hold a saved network.
- 4. Tap **Forget**.
- 5. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 6. **Restart your device**, or your next connection may NOT work

#### **Step 2: Reconnect to WiFi**

- 1. Open your device's Settings app.
- 2. Tap **Network & internet** > **Internet**.
- 3. Tap a listed network (YU Wireless or YU Housing).
- 4. Type your YUAD login credentials, and then select **Next**.
  - "YU Wireless" credentials are entered differently than "YU Housing"
  - See section "Authentication" at the bottom of this article on how to enter credentials depending on WiFi name

**Tip:** After you connect, the network is "Saved." When your device is nearby and Wi-Fi is on, your device automatically connects to this network.

### **Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:**

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 

- YUWireless
- YUHousing
- YUWifi
- 1. Open your phone's Settings app.
- 2. Tap **Network & internet** > **Internet**.
- 3. If needed, turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. At the bottom, tap **Saved networks**.
- 5. In the list, tap the saved network that you want to delete.
- 6. Tap **Forget**.
- 7. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 8. Restart your device, or your next connection may NOT work

- **NOTE:** As of 2/1/2024, the latest Android version (14 and above) will have enhanced security features.
- · As such, WiFi certificate settings need to be EXACT or the phone will not connect to WiFi

### **Step 1: Forget ALL YU wireless networks:**

**CRITICAL:** You must forget ALL YU WiFi Networks listed below **or your connection will never work.** 

- YUWireless
- YUHousing
- YUWifi
- 1. Sign in to your Chromebook.
- 2. At the bottom right, select the time.
- Select Settings .
- 4. In the "Network" section, select Wi-Fi.
- 5. Select Known networks.
- 6. Find the network you want to forget, then select More : > Forget.
- 7. Repeat process for all remaining YU Networks
- 8. **Restart your device**, or your next connection may NOT work

#### **Step 2: Reconnect to WiFi**

- 1. At the bottom right, select the time.
- 2. Select Not Connected ...

**Note**: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.

- 3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.
- 5. Choose a listed network (YU Wireless or YU Housing).
- 6. Type your YUAD login credentials, and then select **Next**.
  - "YU Wireless" credentials are entered differently than "YU Housing"
  - See section "Authentication" at the bottom of this article on how to enter credentials depending on WiFi name

#### WIFI CERTIFICATE SETTINGS FOR CHROMEBOOKS:

As of 2/1/2024, the latest Android version (14 and above) will have enhanced security features.

- As such, WiFi certificate settings need to be EXACT or the Chromebook will not connect to WiFi

## WiFi Authentication:

- **YU Wireless** (Within YU Campus Buildings)
  - Username: Your YU email
  - **Password:** YUAD Password (same as InsideTrack and Canvas)
- **YU Housing** (Available only in Residence Halls/Dormitories)
  - How to Connect:
    - While at the residence, you will see "YUHousing" SSID available as "Public Network"
    - When clicking on "YUHousing", a web Pop-Up will appear as below



- Where it says **LDAP Login**, enter your YU credentials:
  - **login:** YUAD Username (Do NOT use YU email address)
  - password: YUAD Password (same as InsideTrack and Canvas)


