- Use the same login ID as the one used for computers at Ferkauf
- Need to email the IRIS support team first time logging in to get access
- Sync IRIS account with your CITI page by ensuring that they have the same log in email
- IRIS should then import the relevant information about completed CITI courses

Only now can you record information about your study.

- The IRIS study application has 17 sections, and most questions are yes or no but some call for a brief explanation.
- It covers a range of areas like purpose, population, procedures, questionnaires/surveys/consent forms, etc.
- *There were a bunch of questions that looked like they only pertained to medical procedure studies so those sections were easy because you can just say "no" to all the questions.*
- You upload the study documents at the very end.
- You also have to upload the principal investigator's CV and IRIS will email them to get their signature. (*PI is your advisor*)
