

ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CAMPUS SECURITY

The University has established an Advisory Committee on Campus Security in accordance with Section 6431 of Article 129-A of New York State Education Law. The committee is comprised of students, staff and faculty members, and its primary role is to review campus security policies and procedures (including trainings) and make recommendations for improvements, as well as review any additional issues that affect the overall safety and well-being of the campus community and other matters required by Article 129-A of New York State Education Law to be reviewed by the committee. The committee reports its findings and recommendations each academic year in writing to the University President.
