HISTORY: 33 credits. HIS 1101, 1102, plus 27 additional HIST credits, or which at least six credits must be in US History and three in non-western history. With permission of the departmental advisor, up to six credits in Jewish History, beyond those required by the Jewish studies distribution requirement, may count toward the major.

~ Courses that cover both the US and the non-Western world may be counted either a US or as non-Western history, but not both.

~ A maximum of 3 AP credits can be used to fulfill major requirements

➔ A score of 5 on the European AP exam can be used in place of HIST 1101

➔ A score of 5 on the US AP exam can be used in place of one course in US History
