## Fund your education: get started on your FAFSA

Filing early helps ensure that you receive the maximum financial aid for which you are eligible.

Apply for financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [FAFSA.gov](https://fafsa.gov). You will need to include the **YU FAFSA school code 002903**.

New York State residents should complete the supplemental questions for the New York Higher Education Services Corporation (HESC) to be considered for the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) grant.

If you previously submitted your FAFSA, please be on the lookout for your YU financial aid package sent by OSF.

- If you plan to attend an Israel school that is not affiliated with SDA, please choose the option to defer admission when enrolling.
