- *The Advanced Standing Block Summer Program is only open to students holding a bachelor's degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited program.*
- *36 credits total, 28 hours per week internship for a total of 8 credits of field work in fall and spring.*
- *Advanced Clinical majors must take Psychosocial Pathology. Community Social Work majors must take Administration. Group Work majors may select either course.*
- *All Block Program students in the summer, fall, and spring semesters are considered full-time students. The summer program class schedule extends from the beginning of June through the end of July. Field work is from September through May in the student's home base.*
