



Who We Are: CAMBA is a community of staff, volunteers, clients, donors, neighbors and partners who work together to build an inclusive New York City, where all children and adults have access to the resources and supports they need to thrive. Client Care Coordinator (LMSW): The Client Care Coordinator provides individual and/or group counseling services to assist family shelter clients and their families in achieving healthy relationships, emotional stability, personal development and/or adjustment, as well as counsels clients regarding issues such as: abusive behavior, family dynamics, healthy personal choices, substance abuse, and mental and physical health/trauma related issues. Requirements: LMSW required, new MSW graduates pending licensure welcome to apply.

Client Care Supervisor (LCSW): The Client Care Supervisor provides supervision and training to team members on psychoeducation, mental health assessments, and techniques such as motivational interviewing within a CAMBA family shelter. The Client Care Supervisor helps to ensure the smooth day-to-day supervision in social services and consults with professional and technical personnel to bring a multidisciplinary approach to client care, develops linkage agreements, and serves as liaison with other community based organizations and local mental health service providers. Requirements: LCSW or hours towards LCSW required. Supervisory experience preferred.

Clinical Supervisor (LMSW): The Clinical Supervisor helps to ensure the smooth day-to-day running and supervision of social services within a CAMBA single adult shelter. The Clinical Supervisor collaborates with the social services team to develop client programming related to housing, substance abuse treatment, mental health and/or employment. The Clinical Supervisor also provides crisis management and interventions with clients, cultivates teamwork, and ensures consistent services in accordance with program policies and procedures. Requirements: Master's degree required; LMSW, limited permit, or LMHC. Supervisory experience strongly preferred. New MSW graduates pending licensure welcome to apply.

Director of Social Services: The Director of Social Services oversees the day-to-day running, coordination, and supervision of all case management staff and social services at the Park Avenue Family Shelter. The Director of Social Services monitors and tracks client intakes and move-outs, conducts chart reviews and implements Quality Assurance measures, meets with community agencies to assist with high-risk case conferences, and analyzes program data to make improvements in partnership with the Shelter Director. Requirements: Master's degree preferred. Three years of applicable experience, including supervisory experience, required. LMSW preferred.

Shelter Director: The Shelter Director oversees the program operations of Flagstone Family Center, a 160 family DHS shelter. The Shelter Director communicates with CAMBA funders, ensures the shelter complies with funder and CAMBA policies, and works with staff to set performance targets in compliance with contract requirements. The Shelter Director also monitors and implements Quality Assurance measures, prepares contract reports, supervises programmatic activities, and makes program improvements. Requirements: Master's degree preferred. Three years of applicable experience, including supervisory experience, required. LMSW preferred.
