Covered family members can choose their own network general dentist near home, work or school. Cigna's nationwide Dental Care (DHMO) network is the largest in the United States. You can change your dental office at any time and for any reason and our change will effective the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month.

If you require specialty care (except pediatric or orthodontic), your network dentist will refer you to a network specialist. (You do not need a referral for children under seven years old to visit a network pediatric dentist).

The Cigna DHMO may be right for you because there are:

- No deductibles
- No dollar maximums
- Easy to understand costs the amount you are responsible for any given procedure is clearly listed on your Patient Charge Schedule (PCS)
- ➢ No claim forms

## Important: If you receive covered services from a dentist who does not participate in the DHMO network, your plan will not pay except in the case of an emergency.
