- **Students in the Neuropsychology minor must ensure that their externship does not interfere with required courses for the minor.*

Exceptions for Neuropsychology Minors

- Students pursuing a neuropsychology minor will be unable to enroll in the dual track
- Students pursuing a neuropsychology minor will be excused from their Category C requirement, *or* one of their Category A (for students completing two years of the CBT track) or Category B (for students completing two years of the psychodynamic track).
- Students who take fewer credits in their 1st or 2nd year due to transferred credits from a master's level program, are also able to adopt to take neuropsychology requirements in those years.
- Students in this track must delay their psychotherapy co-requisites to their 4th year, and make other accommodations as detailed below depending on their therapy track and half of the alphabet.
- Students doing two years of the psychodynamic therapy track may take History & Systems with the Clinical PhD Health Emphasis Program (with permission from instructor) in the Fall in order to accommodate both Object Relations and Self Psychology in the Spring.

Schedule Adjustments

Several exceptions can be made for students trying to complete their neuropsychology minor before their 4th year (i.e., completed within the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year of the program). Students interested in making changes to their course schedules must meet with their academic advisor and the program director for approval. Students pursuing an accelerated neuropsychology minor will likely need to make this decision in their first year.

Depending on which psychotherapy track is selected (i.e., either two years of CBT or two years of psychodynamic) and the student's half of the alphabet, students will be offered several accommodations to help them complete the neuropsychology minor before their 4th year. The specific accommodations are detailed in the sample schedules below. Please note, the following are based on 2021-2022 academic schedules.

- Completion of psychodynamic electives (Interpersonal, Object Relations, and Self Psychology) will be delayed to the end of their 4th year
- Can take Dreams in Psychotherapy as an alternative psychodynamic elective if needed
- To accommodate Object Relations, Self-Psychology and CABB in the Spring, students in this group will need to take History & Systems with the Health Program in the Fall

- Further accommodations will be made to take both Physiological Psychology and Neuroscience of Human Behavior, Cognitions and Affect (both currently scheduled for Tues 12-2 of the 2nd year)
