SCW will pay for up to 10 FIT credits (FIT courses are generally 1.5 – 2 credits and meet once per week). All Studio Art majors must meet with Prof. Tullius to plan appropriate courses for their area of emphasis. Students must take at least one studio course at SCW before registering at FIT.

Senior Project is a 2 semester course and must be taken by the term a student expects to graduate.

A January graduate would register for Senior project in the Spring semester of the term prior to graduation, and in the final Fall semester. A May graduate would register for Senior project in both Fall and Spring of Senior Year.

The exit requirement consists of an independent studio project designed by the student to reflect her area of emphasis. Completion and presentation of the student's Senior Project as well as participation in the annual Stern Senior art exhibition at the YU Museum are required.
