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The study of music has been at the heart of the humanities since the beginning of the Common Era. Courses are designed to give students in any field experience with the pleasures of music study and performance. Courses teach the basic tools of music theory (counterpoint, harmony and analysis), knowledge of music history and some experience in composition. Performance in chamber ensembles and chorus is encouraged. Credit is offered to majors and minors studying an instrument with a private instructor. Students should meet with a faculty member to discuss their area of concentration and plan a course of study.
