The women’s studies minor (15 credits) offers students the opportunity to take an inter-disciplinary approach to the study of women and society. Following an introductory course, students may choose from among designated courses in the departments of art, English, history, Jewish studies, psychology, and sociology. Twelve (12) of these credits may apply toward the “elective” category of the General Education requirements. The remaining 3 credits may apply toward the “Interpreting Literature and Art” or the “Contemporary US and Global Perspective” category if so indicated in the course schedule. Specific courses counting toward the minor are listed in the course schedule for each semester.
