TRANSFER STUDENTS: For immigration purposes term “Transfer” means changing universities or schools inside the U.S. This can occur at the beginning, middle or end of a degree program or between degrees/end of OPT. As a student with F-1 status, your active immigration record can only be maintained by one institution in SEVIS. If you decide to transfer to another institution, your SEVIS record must be released to the “Transfer-in” school AND you need a new I-20.

You are eligible for a transfer if you hold valid F-1 status at the time of transfer and have maintained your status. In addition, you must request a transfer within 60 days after the program completion date or OPT end date, whichever is later. If you are currently on OPT, your OPT employment benefits end the date your current institution releases your SEVIS record to Yeshiva University.

IMPORTANT: As a Transfer student, if you leave the U.S. in between schools, you must use a Form I-20 issued by Yeshiva University when you return to the U.S. to begin your academic program at YU.

STUDY IN ANOTHER IMMIGRATION STATUS:

PART 5: STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Living expenses are estimated for budgeting purposes. Students should also expect a 5% to 7% increase in all expenses every year. If your spouse and/or children will accompany you in F-2 dependent status, please add \$6,500 for a spouse and \$3,500 per child (per year) and include a copy of their passport identity page.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES:

- Document all sources of financial support. Students may show multiple sources of funding.
- All financial documentation must be on letterhead, note the name of the sponsor and be in **English**. Typically, sponsors provide:
 - A bank account/brokerage account showing enough money for the full-length of your academic program OR,
 - A bank account/brokerage account showing enough money for the first year AND proof of income (tax return plus pay stubs or salary letter).
- Bank statements may be no older than 3 months.
- Sponsors promising free room and board must show a lease or deed with sponsor's name AND proof of income (see below).
- Documentation may be scanned, however, Yeshiva University reserves the right to request original documentation if necessary to determine financial capability.

Examples of personal documents (if you will support yourself):

- Bank/asset statement (from last three months) and/or
- Salary letter from your employer

Examples of Yeshiva University: Submit documentation of scholarship, grant, loan, etc. If your enrollment is dependent upon receiving financial aid, you must submit proof of the award in order for this application to be evaluated.

- Scholarship/grant
- YU Loan

Examples of Cash Sponsor's Documents:

- Bank/investment statements for the last 3 months.
- If your sponsor is unable to show sufficient money for your entire program, also ask them to provide a tax return and the 3 most recent pay stubs or current salary letter.
- Each owner of the account must sign a separate "Promise of Cash Support."

Free Room and Board Sponsor's Documents: (Students living in a YU dormitory or with an F-1 spouse cannot claim free room and board.)

- Proof of residence (e.g., lease, deed, rent receipt, phone bill) AND
- Proof of income (income tax return with most recent pay stub or letter from your employer) OR
- Bank/investment statements for the last 3 months.
- Sponsor's Promise of Free Room and Board.
- Each owner of the account must sign a separate "Promise of Cash Support."
