What You'll Do

Help families experiencing homelessness get their lives back on track! As a Client Care Coordinator at one of our shelters for families with children, you'll help families in crisis with mental health, domestic violence, and substance abuse counseling; work with children who have experienced trauma and may have other special needs; and fortify the strengths of each family. You'll complete psychosocial assessments and participate in our multidisciplinary service team approach to ensure positive outcomes for the families we serve. And **you'll gain supervised clinical hours needed to advance in your career.**

You're a good fit for this role if you have:

- Current LMSW or LMHC license or expect to receive your license within three to six months.
- Compassion and respect for parents and children who are experiencing homelessness.
- Knowledge of child and adolescent development, emotional/behavioral health, mental health, parent-child relationship family dynamics, and diagnostic classification.

It would be great (but not required) if you are:

- Bilingual (English/Spanish), since many of our clients are native Spanish speakers.
