Floating Holidays

Two (2) floating holidays may be taken. Employees may choose two of the following days: President's Day (February 20), Purim (March 7), one day during Passover (April 5 - April 13), Juneteenth (June 19), Columbus Day/Indigenous People's Day (October 9), one day during Chanukah (December 8 - December 15), Christmas Day (December 25). It is expected that offices will remain open during these days. Union members should communicate with their supervisors about the union floating holiday arrangement and the notice required to schedule these days.
