	Floating Holidays

Two (2) floating holidays may be taken. Employees may choose two of the following days: President's Day (February 19), Purim (March 24), one day during Passover (April 23 - April 30), Juneteenth (June 19), Tisha Ba'av (August 13), Columbus Day/Indigenous People's Day (October 14), Christmas Day (December 25), one day during Chanukah (December 26 – January 2). It is expected that offices will remain open during these days. *Union members have a different floating holiday arrangement and must communicate with their supervisors about the union floating holiday agreement and the notice they must provide to schedule the days*.
