Floating Holidays

Two (2) floating holidays may be taken. Non-union employees may choose any two of the following days: President's Day (February 17), Purim (March 3), one day during Passover (April 2-9), Juneteenth (June 19), Tisha Ba'av (July 23), Columbus Day/Indigenous People's Day (October 13), Christmas Day (December 25), one day during Chanukah (December 5-12). It is expected that offices will remain open during these days. *Union members have a different floating holiday arrangement and must communicate with their supervisors about the union floating holiday agreement and the notice they must provide to schedule the days*.
