**PLEASE NOTE:**

1. Israel-based students are required to take: SWK 6003, SWK 6004, SWK 6013, SWK 6014 and SWK 6210 at HUJ.
2. Israel-based students are required to complete their fieldwork in Israel
3. Israel-based students are permitted to take no more than 15% of their courses online. Due to the licensure guidelines, we recommend you reserve the online option for your electives.
4. Students from Israel have the option to take courses in both the Summer Block I or Summer Block II schedules (*these schedules overlap for 2 weeks in July-please avoid time conflicts on your class schedule*)
5. The Summer Block I schedule runs from early June until the end of July
6. The Summer Block II Hybrid Program schedule extends from beginning of July through mid-August
7. HUJ and Wurzweiler Course Schedules follow separate calendars; **start and end dates are different**. Israel-based students will be provided both calendars prior to the beginning of each fall semester.
