Students must take 24 credits of advanced level Jewish Studies beyond those used to meet the Jewish Studies requirements of 36 credits/18 courses. The required distribution of these 18 courses is 1 course in each of the following: BBLE, JUDS, JHIS, and JPHI. HEBR language requirement is based on placement.

Major courses may be taken only in 1 or 2 areas of specialization (BBLE, JUDS, JHIS, and JPHI). At least 3 courses must be completed in the chosen area(s) of specialization. [With permission of the department chair, a student may take one course outside of the one or two areas, if it relates to other courses in her major.]

Students whose focus is **BBLE** must include at least:

- 1. One (1) course in medieval or modern exegetical methods (BBLE 1081-1097)
- 2. One (1) course in a specific book of Tanakh

Students whose focus is **JUDS** must include at least:

- 1. One (1) text based course
- 2. One (1) development of halakhah course

Students whose focus is **JHIS** must include at least.

- 1. One (1) course from ancient or medieval period
- 2. One (1) course from the modern period

Students whose focus is **JPHI** must include at least:

- 1. One (1) course from the medieval period
- 2. One (1) course from the modern period

Jewish Studies Minor Total Credits: 15

Students must take 15 credits of advanced level Jewish Studies beyond those used to meet the Jewish Studies requirements of 36 credits/18 courses.

Minor courses may be taken only in 1 or 2 areas of specialization (BBLE, JUDS, JHIS, and JPHI).
