

### Jewish Studies major

The major in Jewish Studies consists of 11 courses beyond the JCore requirements, totaling no less than 31 credits, divided into three groups:

1. A *concentration* in one of seven categories, either a *discipline* (Jewish History, Hebrew, Bible, or Jewish Thought and Philosophy) or a *time period* (Ancient [from the beginnings through the rabbinic period], Medieval, and Modern);
2. Three further courses within Jewish Studies;
3. *Correlate* courses, typically drawn from other departments in the Humanities (history, philosophy, literature) or the Social Sciences (such as psychology or sociology) which *correlate* with your studies within Jewish Studies.

The **minor in Jewish Studies** consists of five courses, totaling no less than 13 credits, beyond the JCore requirements.
