ONLINE COURSES POLICY

The three undergraduate colleges recently adopted the following **policy regarding online courses**:

- **Summer Courses**
Summer online YU courses will continue to be offered and accepted, while those offered by other institutions will be considered. As per the current practice, students will need to file the Request for Outside Courses Form to receive approval for outside online courses. Online courses from community colleges or for-profit institutions will not be accepted. Business courses must be from an AACSB accredited institution.
- **Cap of online courses toward the Bachelor's Degree**
Students may count a maximum of 4 online courses toward their undergraduate degrees. A maximum of two online courses may be applied toward the major and a maximum of two online courses may apply toward the general education requirements.
- **Residency Requirement**
All online YU courses, including those offered by YU graduate schools, will count toward the YU residency requirement.
- **Alert:** Students interested in health professions should check with an advisor before taking online courses.
