All English and Psychology courses not on the pre-approved list will require course syllabi for review by the Department.</li> <li>To receive credit, you must complete approved courses with a grade of "C" or better. Grades earned in these courses will not be figured into your GPA at Yeshiva University.</li> <li>No requirements may be taken pass/fail. Students may take one elective course pass/fail over the summer only if the college indicates on the transcript that "P" is awarded for "C" (not "C-") or better.</li> <li>A summer course must last at least four complete calendar weeks.</li> <li>Approved summer English courses must last at least 5 complete calendar weeks.</li> <li>The number of credits may be taken during a 4-week period.</li> <li>For sessions longer than 4 weeks, no more than x+2 credits may be taken, where x is the number of weeks (e.g., no more than 7 credits may be taken during a 5-week session).</li> <li>For example, you may take two 4-credit courses during a 6-week summer session, but you may take only one 4-credit course during a 4-week summer session.</li> <li>You may take no more than two courses during any one summer session.</li> <li>The total number of credits you may take during one summer is nine credits. The total number of courses you may take during one summer is nine credits; 5 quarter credits equal 3 transfer credits.</li> <li>For Business Majors taking their required economics courses outside Yeshiva College, courses taken at schools on the quarter system, 4 quarter credits equal 2.5 transfer credits; 5 quarter credits required by Yeshiva College. For example, a Money &amp; Banking course taken on the quarter system for 4 credits will be considered only 2½ credits of Money &amp; Banking and will not fulfill the requirement.</li> <li>For Yeshiva College students, the corresponding major or general requirement is still fulfilled.</li> </ul>
