Important Reminders

- If you are on academic probation at the end of the current term, this permit will be automatically cancelled.
- No approval will be granted for online courses, correspondence courses, or courses taken at any community college.
- Submit all course descriptions for courses not approved in the Summer School Course Database. All English and Psychology courses not on the pre-approved list will require course syllabi for review by the Department.
- To receive credit, you must complete approved courses with a grade of "C" or better. Grades earned in these courses will not be figured into your GPA at Yeshiva University.
- No requirements may be taken pass/fail. Students may take one elective course pass/fail over the summer only if the college indicates on the transcript that "P" is awarded for "C" (not "C-") or better.
- A summer course must last at least four complete calendar weeks.
- Approved summer English courses must last at least 5 complete calendar weeks.
- The number of credits you may take during a summer session depends on the length of the summer session:
 - A maximum of 4 credits may be taken during a 4-week period.
 - For sessions longer than 4 weeks, no more than x+2 credits may be taken, where x is the number of weeks (e.g., no more than 7 credits may be taken during a 5-week session).

For example, you may take two 4-credit courses during a 6-week summer session, but you may take only one 4-credit course during a 4-week summer session.
- You may take no more than two courses during any one summer session.
- The total number of credits you may take during one summer is nine credits. The total number of courses you may take during one summer is three courses.
- In schools on the quarter system, 4 quarter credits equal 2.5 transfer credits; 5 quarter credits equal 3 transfer credits.
 - For Business Majors taking their required economics courses outside Yeshiva College, courses taken at schools on the quarter system will not fulfill requirements unless they are equivalent to the number of credits required by Yeshiva College. For example, a Money & Banking course taken on the quarter system for 4 credits will be considered only 2½ credits of Money & Banking and will not fulfill the requirement.
 - For Yeshiva College students, the corresponding major or general requirement is still fulfilled.
