- 1. This roadmap is for advanced standing students from an accredited Israeli university.
- 2. Advanced Standing students need two electives to graduate.
- 3. Israel-based students are required to take: SWK 6013, SWK 6014 and SWK 6210 at HUJ.
- 4. Israel-based students are required to complete their fieldwork in Israel.
