PLEASE NOTE:

1. This roadmap is for advanced standing students from an accredited Israeli university.
2. Advanced Standing students need two electives to graduate.
3. Israel-based students are required to take: SWK 6013, SWK 6014 and SWK 6210 at HUU.
4. Israel-based students are required to complete their fieldwork in Israel.
5. Students from Israel have the option to take courses in both the Summer Block I or Summer Block II schedules *(these schedules overlap for 2 weeks in July-please avoid time conflicts on your class schedule)*.
6. The Summer Block I schedule runs from early June until the end of July.
7. The Summer Block II Hybrid Program schedule extends from beginning of July through mid-August.
8. HUU and Wurzweiler Course Schedules follow separate calendars; **start and end dates are different**. Israel-based students will be provided both calendars prior to the beginning of each fall semester.
