Dear Chaver,

Elul Zman at Yeshiva is now under way and the talmidim have returned to their learning. Baruch Hashem, the Batei Midrash are buzzing once again with a thunderous Kol Torah. The opening shiur by Rav Hershel Schachter on Maseches Bava Kama was exhilarating and most exciting as we begin to motivate the talmidim toward great hasmada.

It is at this time each year that we remind you that your Yeshiva needs your support. Baruch Hashem, the Yeshiva has made great strides towards financial stability, however it still requires extensive communal and alumni support to ensure that RIETS can continue to grow in its mission and influence the lives of our talmidim and the community.

- **20** in Kollelei Elyon
- **35** in the YU Israel Kollel in Jerusalem

RIETS has developed the **most comprehensive rabbinic training program in the world**, including:

- An ever-expanding curriculum of halachic limmudim
- More opportunities for the in-depth study of Hilchos Niddah, Aveilus and Shabbos
- New courses in professional rabbinics led by our dynamic, full-time Director of Professional Rabbinics, our chaver Rabbi Larry Rothwachs, the Rav of Congregation Beth Aaron in Teaneck
- A joint program in Pastoral Counseling with YU's Ferkauf Graduate School of Psychology
- A cutting-edge personal development program for semicha students (and their wives) to deal with the "inner-life" and stresses of the rabbi and the rabbinic family, led by our chaver Rabbi Neal Turk. This includes multiple courses, processing work with mental health professionals, individual sessions for all pulpit track students with our chaver Rabbi Dr. Alex Mondrow, standardized testing for emotional intelligence and more.

- Special chomer lidrush phone calls for rabbis on the parsha and chagim with leading shul rabbis and prominent community rabbonim
- Chavrusa Magazine, lifecycle notices, and monthly update emails
- Rabbinic Alumni Loan Fund, assisting chaverim in extenuating circumstances with interest-free loans
- Yarchei Kallah conferences coordinated by Rabbi Dr. Jacob J. Schacter, University Professor of Jewish History and Jewish Thought and Senior Scholar at the Center for the Jewish Future
- Rebbetzin's Yarchei Kallah, which attracts approximately 100 participants from around the globe

- The Gertrude and Morris Bienenfeld Department of Jewish Career Development and Placement, led by our chaver Rabbi Ronald Schwarzberg, which is involved in the placement of more than 50 rabbis every year
- A very active YUConnects Shidduchim program which has created more than 330 new shidduchim


