

Report on the 2017 Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary Campus Climate Survey

Fall 2017

The Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary Campus Climate Survey is designed by RIETS Campus Climate Survey Committee to ascertain general awareness and knowledge of the institution's prevention and response to sexual assault. In Fall 2017, all RIETS students were invited to take the survey. The survey is anonymous and confidential. Of the total of 265 RIETS students, 56 students responded to the survey, resulting in a response rate of 21%. Following are the results of the survey.
