Prior to joining Tyco Rob was responsible for Technical Accounting Research for Cendant Corporation and was instrumental in the spin-off and sale of Cendant Corporation into four separate companies. Prior to Joining Cendant, Rob worked for Lucent Technologies and KPMG.
