II. ACADEMIC GUIDELINES:

1. WORKLOAD:

- a. The maximum workload is **seven** courses of 21 credits per semester. This includes courses taken at FIT, AGS, etc. See the sheet on workload guidelines for more details.
- b. Students on probation may take no more than **six** courses or 17 credits a semester.
- 2. Course descriptions and their prerequisites are found on each department's web page. Prerequisites are also listed in the course schedule.
- 3. **Jewish Studies** courses are listed by subject and arranged by level in the back of the booklet.

III. REQUIREMENTS:

The comments in the Notes column indicate which requirement a given course fulfills.

IV. ENGLISH COMPOSITION REQUIREMENT

All students must take English 1100 (Composition & Rhetoric) during either the Fall or Spring of their first year of attendance.

V. SPECIAL OPTIONS:

- A Waiver of Prerequisite is required for courses that do not have pre-reqs. See Academic Advisement website.
- Most students may choose one elective each semester to be graded P or N. The period to file for this option is March 26-28. Forms and guidelines are available on the Office of the Registrar website.
- 3. Independent Study, Directed Study, Internship, and Audit forms must be filed by Wednesday, January 31. These courses, except for audit, become part of your workload.
- 4. **Honors** courses are indicated in the **Notes** column of the schedule. To be eligible for these courses, a student must have a high school average of 90 or above, or Dean's List status (GPA of 3.5 or above for the year). Honors courses may not be taken on a P/N basis.
- Permission is required to take courses at the Azrieli Graduate School or the Bernard Revel Graduate School.
- VI. A given course is not necessarily offered every semester. Be careful to take a course required for your major when it is offered, keeping prerequisites in mind.
- VII. No credit will be granted for a repeated course. Check course numbers carefully before registering!
- VIII. Yeshiva University has adopted regulations to protect the privacy rights of students under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974. Regulations are available from the Office of the Registrar.

Only one course in the major may count toward the general education requirements, with the exception of a science major in which the first year sequence counts toward the Science and Technology category. Exceptions may also apply toward the Quantitative Skills requirement.

III. Jewish Studies Requirements

- SCW/SSSB students are required to complete 22 courses in Jewish Studies [JS] except as indicated Exceptions below.
- A minimum of two Jewish Studies courses is required in each semester of attendance.
- A minimum of 16 credits in Jewish Studies must be taken on the Beren Campus.

Exceptions:

- Students pursuing 3-2 Combined Programs in Occupational Therapy, Optometry, Physical Therapy, Physician Assistant and Podiatry (3 years on campus or one year in Israel and two years on campus):
 - Those doing three years on the Beren Campus take a total of 17 JS courses [3 JS courses during semesters 1-5 and 2 JS courses in semester 6].
 - Those who earn credit for one year of study in Israel take 2 JS courses per semester during each of the four remaining semesters on campus.
 - Both groups meet the JS distribution
- Shanna Bet students may opt to take a 1 credit Beit Midrash class for up to two semesters. This
 will count as the second of their 2 JS classes. Note that the class will not count towards their
 distribution requirement. Interested students should contact Dr. Deena Rabinovich at
 <u>drabinov@yu.edu</u> to see if they qualify for this class.
- Transfer students and students interested in other combined/joint programs should meet with the JS academic advisor regarding their JS requirements.
- Katz/AA degree recipients who are transferring to Stern/Syms
 - Those students who have spent a year of study in Israel will be required to take 2 JS courses a semester during each of the remaining four semesters on the Beren campus.
 - Those students who have not spent a year of study in Israel will take 3 JS courses for their first semester on the Beren campus and two JS courses for their remaining three semesters on the Beren campus.

- IV. Residency Students must complete at least 84 credits and 6 full-time (12 credits) semesters on SCW's NY campus. Transfer students consult with an academic advisor regarding the residency requirement.
 - 60% of the major and minor must be completed at SCW in NY.
 - Up to 12 credits of approved courses at AGS and BRGS may apply toward the SCW residency requirement.

- VI. Honors at graduation are based on the GPA for courses taken in residence: Cum Laude 3.500, Magna Cum Laude, 3.700; Summa Cum Laude, 3.850.


