

The Ramaz Upper School seeks a full-time Health Education Teacher for grades 9-11 to begin September 2021/2022 school year.

The Health Teacher is responsible for creating a classroom environment that fosters, promotes and develops an understanding of key developmental issues effecting healthy functioning. The health curriculum aims to cultivate age appropriate physical, social and emotional adjustment. Curricular topics include; exercise, nutrition, self-esteem, mental health, mindfulness, stress management, healthy relationships, prevention of and risks associated with substance experimentation, and sex education.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Develop and implement comprehensive health lessons in which each student has an enhanced understanding of issues that impact healthy development. The classroom environment should be an interactive safe space to discuss topics in-depth with plans for implementation of skills.
- Provide positive role modeling of appropriate and respectful interactions with students and staff.
- Attend faculty meetings and conferences.
- Maintain consistent relationships with families when necessary, including phone calls, emails and conferences.
- Act as a team player to engage with the wider school culture.

Skills and Competencies:

- Candidates must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the concepts of physical education, safety, child growth and development, effective progressive instructional strategies, classroom management, and research related to learning.
- Have experience designing and evaluating curriculum for Health Education and instruction.
- Ability to organize and manage multiple priorities.
- Exhibit enthusiasm and well-developed interpersonal skills to relate well with students, staff, administration, parents and the community.
- Flexibility and ability to cope with change.

Qualifications Required :

- Bachelor's degree, Master's degree preferred
- Certification in Health Education preferred
- Experience working with high school students in an independent school
