

Mental Health Coordinator

We are seeking a skilled mental health professional, experienced in working with children, adolescents and young adults to support the emotional and behavioral needs of our children and staff. Under the supervision of the Westchester Summer Day Director, the Mental Health professional is responsible for collaborating with the leadership team to develop and implement mental health support structures for children and staff. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and expertise with behavioral intervention are required.

General Responsibilities:

- Assist with staff training to promote a psychologically safe and nurturing environment and develop skills for supervision of children, promoting group dynamics, and understanding and supporting a diverse population of children
- Assist staff and summer leadership in problem solving and implementing interventions for behavioral and emotional issues in children and staff
- Serve as resource for developmental framework and understanding of behavior
- Liaison with parents, providing referrals for support outside of the program as needed
- Work with individual children and groups as directed by the WSD Director
- Maintain appropriate records of interactions with children and staff
