Current List of Services RIETS Offers Alumni:

- The Morris and Gertrude Bienenfeld Department of Jewish Career Development and Placement works to help each RIETS alumnus find appropriate and meaningful work.
- Continuing Rabbinic Education courses are certificate-granting courses that develop a wide range of practical rabbinic skills for rabbis in the field.
- Rabbanan.org is RIETS' free, password-protected site with resources for rabbis including ideas for drashas, Jewish thought on current events, stories, and more.
- The Wolf Chomer Lidrush program provides inspirational content from master darshanim for parsha and chagim and helps rabbis creatively develop sermons and shiurim.
- Exclusive access to the Real Life Rabbinics Podcast, hosted by RIETS staff and featuring musmachim on a variety of topics.
- Our musmachim can host their shiurim on YUTorah Online, making them available to the broader community. These can also be embedded within your institution's website. YUTorah offers over 400,000 shiurim by our roshei yeshiva and other YU luminaries via webcast in audio, video, and text formats.
- The Yarchei Kallah is a rabbinic development fellowship for select rabbis guided by Rabbi Jacob J. Schacter. The programming addresses content and skills development and an alumni program that convenes around major contemporary issues.
- Alumni Shiurim and chizzuk opportunities are offered semi-regularly to talmidim of individual Roshei Yeshiva.
- Lifecycle announcements and email updates are regularly communicated.
- All alumni have access to the campus and library, as well as access to the Bar Ilan Responsa Project and Otzar Hachochma by applying for library database access [here](#).
- Recent pulpit alumni are given mentorship opportunities with experienced rabbanim and small cohorts as they transition into their new roles.
