

YOUR APPLICATION

Your applications are submitted electronically to medical or dental schools via the following services:

Medical: American Medical College Application (AMCAS)

Dental: Associated American Dental Schools Application Service (AADSAS)

Osteopathic: American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine (AACOMAS)

Submission Dates

All three online applications go live during the first week of June. However, AMCAS opens a month earlier to allow students to enter information.

Sections

All applications have the same basic sections:

Biographical Info: Basic birth date, legal residence, siblings, contact information.

Schools Attended: You must list every post-high school institution (US or Canada) you have attended, including in yeshivas in Israel. You must order transcripts from each.

Classwork: Your classwork and grades should be inputted exactly as it appears on your Yeshiva College transcript. There are special considerations for inputting your coursework during your time in Israel. This will be explained in detail during the AMCAS and AADSAS Overview Sessions in the spring. NOTE: You will not have to input your morning classes.

Experience: All of your post-high school volunteer, research, extracurricular activities, paid employment, and honors.


Letters of Evaluation: You input the Pre-Health Director's contact information to inform AMCAS/AADSAS that a committee letter will be coming from YU. The letters are sent during the verification process after your application is submitted.

Personal Statement: See separate section.

Designated Schools: Input list of schools you wish to receive your application. NOTE: This is the one section that can be updated AFTER your application has been submitted. You can add additional schools, but not delete any.

Verification Process

Once you submit your application, it does not go directly to your selected schools. There is a 4-6 week “verification” process in which AMCAS/AADSAS compiles your MCAT/DAT scores, receives committee letter packet, and compares your grades against your transcript. Only completed, verified applications are transmitted to the schools on your list.



Application Overview Session

The pre-health office has a MANDATORY review session in late May before the applications go live for both the AMCAS and AADSAS application which will take the applicants step-by-step through the process.

Israeli Schools

Each of the major Israeli schools (Technion, Ben Gurion, Sackler) have separate applications which can be accessed through their web site.
